

# Henry O. Flipper Scholarship Program

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The Henry O. Flipper Chapter of the National African American Gun Association (NAAGA) is accepting applications for the school year 2025-2026

### **Eligibility Criteria**

## To all applicants:

- 1. You must be a graduating high school student of the current year.
- 2. You must provide an official high school transcript with your application.
- 3. You must be a resident of El Paso County, TX, and a US citizen.
- 4. You must provide an acceptance letter from the Community/Technical College, Four-Year College, or University you will attend, full or part-time enrollment is accepted.
- 5. You must provide two (2) letters of recommendation, from any school official (Teacher, Coach, etc.) and/or organization (Church, Job Supervisor, etc.) that you are involved in.
- 6. You must submit a 200 word essay, legibly typed on the legacy of Henry O. Flipper.
- 7. You must provide a photo of yourself with your application.
- 8. You must submit a completed application signed by you and your sponsor, and all documents, via email (elpnaaga@yahoo.com) by the deadline date.
- 9. This scholarship is open to all, regardless of race, color, gender, age, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, or physical disability of the person.

# All applicants will be graded and selected on a point system as outlined below:

| 6. | NAAGA member or Family member of | 10 points (Current when submitted)             |
