

The NEST's purpose is to work together to solve problems, providing assistance with physical needs, emotional support, verbal communication, food, water, household supplies, computer technology, guns, logistics, and security. The team's collective preparedness is essential for survival, especially in long-term survival scenarios where protection and security are critical. The ideal number for a NEST is six to nine people, allowing for effective movement, self-sustainability, and security. The NEST is a testament to the importance of community support and the collective mindset of working together to overcome challenges.
